
CWDC (Collegiate Women Development Cell) is functioning in Government Science College, Gandhinagar, under which useful information is provided to the students and their developmental programs are planned and equipments required by them are also purchased. Periodic progress reports during the year 2020-2021 are presented below. Moreover, during this year, with the inspiration and permission of the Principal, a poster has been put up in the ladies room for the purpose of informing the students about the laws. Posters of important helpline numbers have also been prepared.

This year, necessary furniture, notice board, mirror, dustbin, etc. and other equipments have been purchased in the ladies room and utility room so that the students do not face any problem in the college and their basic facilities are maintained.

Apart from this, one sanitary pad vending machine and three sanitary pad disposal machines have been purchased for the students under the grant of RUSA Component-9 for the year 2020-21 CWDC. The students participated enthusiastically in this event and the following students won the first three positions.




