2. Objectives of the Practice

To impart soft skills training and spoken English training, as well as to develop personality and employability of final year students of the college.

3. The Context

To prepare graduating students for better employability, industry readiness and prosperous career through appropriate interventions is the current need of higher education system. The need can be fulfilled by online training in covid pandemic.

4. The Practice

Uniquely, this training program blends traditional academic learning with practical soft skill building practices, shaping or polishing students for the demands of the modern competitive workplace.
