- ✓ Take feedback from employers and Students who get employed.

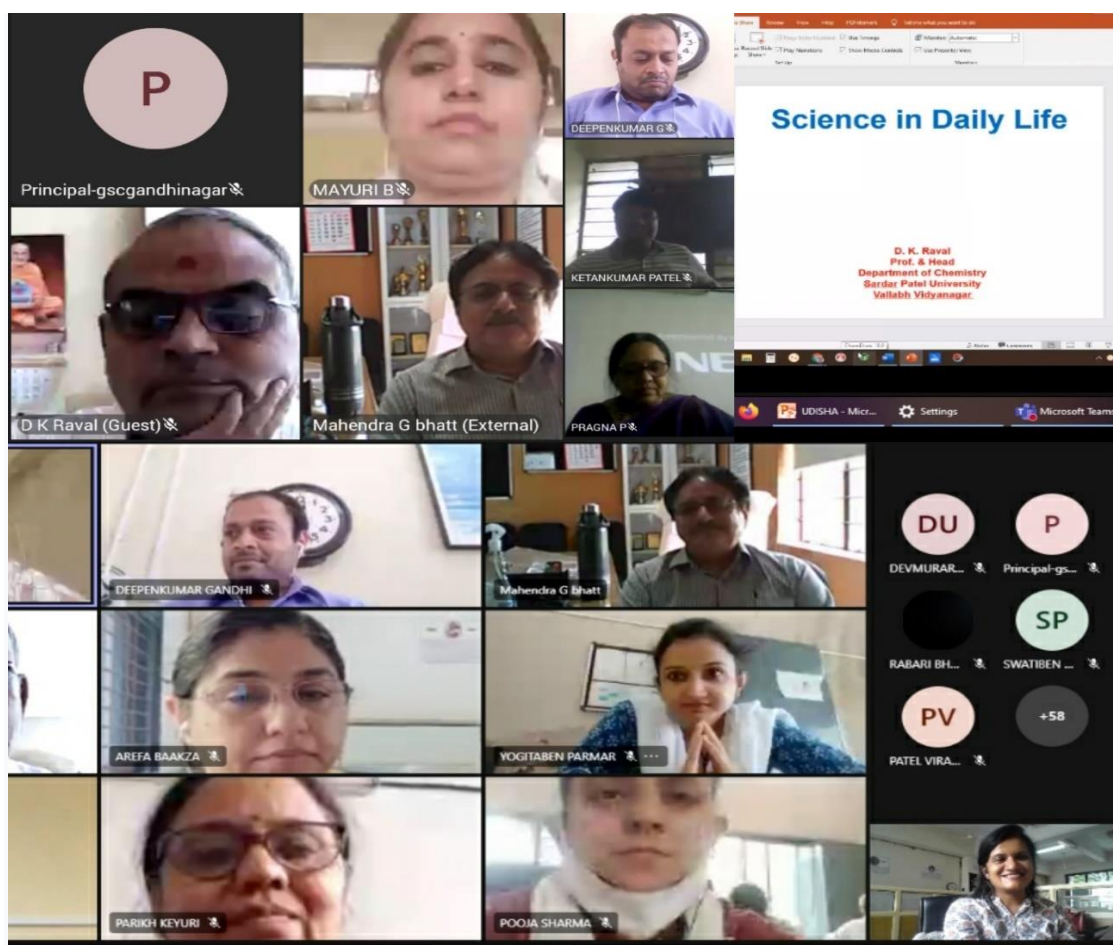

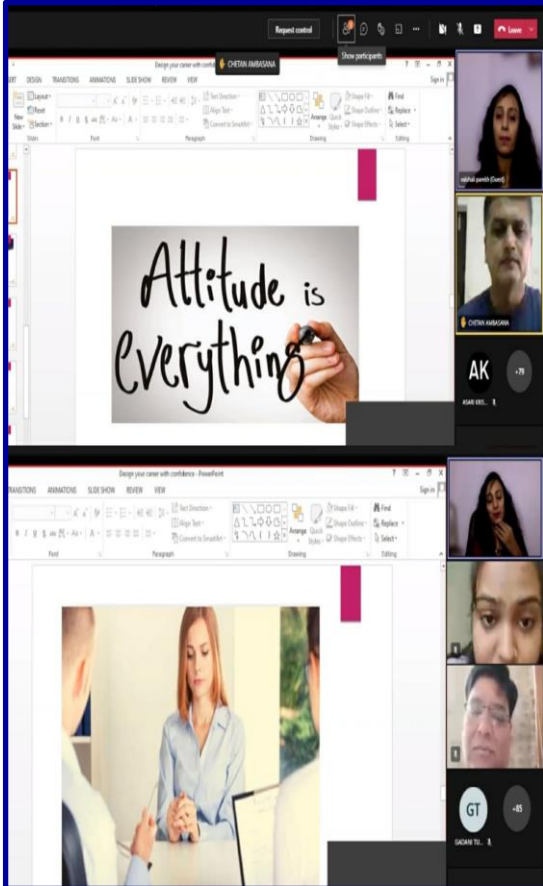

Seminar on “Design your career with confidence

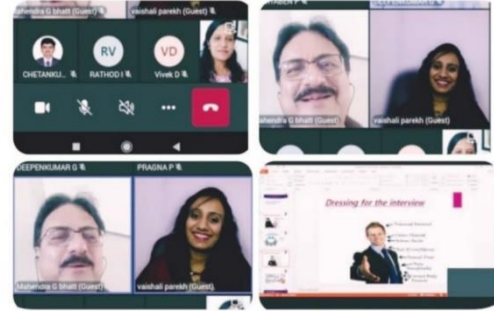
Date: 05 October, 2021

Directorate of Employment & Training (working under the department of labour and skill development & employment Department, Government of Gujarat), has been in the forefront of implementing various skill-building programs with the aim of helping people get jobs. The government of Gujarat has launched Anubandham Portal for the citizens of Gujarat on 06 August, 2021. With the motto of “हर हाथ को काम, हर खेत को पानी”, Anubandham aims to bring together Job Seeker and Job Provider at one place. Through this portal, employers can hire a workforce and the job seekers will be able to get employment.

The employers will be able to upload their job vacancies and the job seekers will be able to apply for the open vacancies according to their eligibility. The government has launched this portal keeping in mind the need for employment amongst youth.

The main objective of the Anubandham Portal is to provide a common space for employees to post vacancies and unemployed candidates to apply through it. This portal will sort out the problem of unemployment in the state. Now citizens will be able to apply for the job of their choice from the comfort of their homes. They are not required to go anywhere in order to apply for a job. This will save a lot of time and money and will also bring transparency to the system.

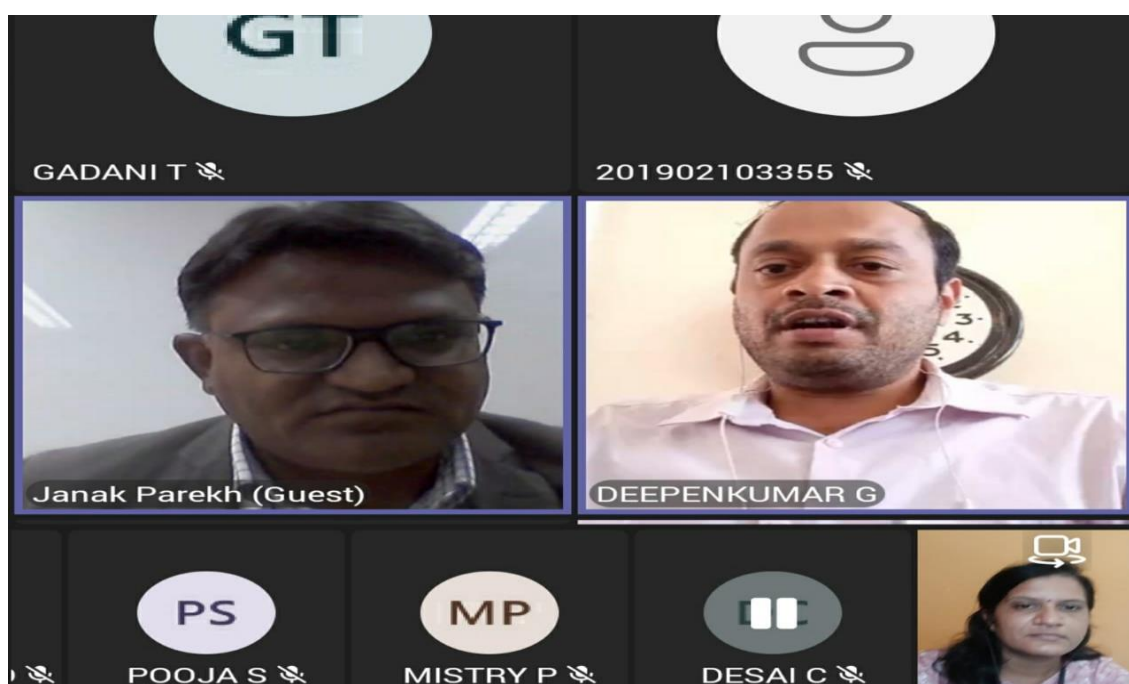

Lecture on “ Nonverbal Communication”

Date: 21 January, 2022

Nonverbal communication plays a significant role in our lives, as it can improve a person's ability to relate, engage, and establish meaningful interactions in everyday life. To educate the students on this theme, an online lecture was conducted by Dr. Mehul Dave, Associate professor and head, Department of life sciences, IITE, Gandhinagar. Dr. Dave explained that Nonverbal communication is conveying your message through gestures, postures, signals, or clues. In our personal and professional lives, we give and receive countless nonverbal clues every day. He further demonstrated various models of different gestures with live examples to convey his message. Students got to learn that “The most important thing in communication is hearing what isn't said”.

Students showed interest by asking the impact of nonverbal communication during job interviews & also how to impress the interviewer along with the impact of the same at workplace. Dr. Dave emphasised that the boss communicating positive nonverbal cues when speaking with employees can increase employee morale, as well as their job performance.

The session was smoothly covered by Dr. Jignasha Thumar- Chairmen, UDISHA committee. Principal Dr. M. G. Bhatt appreciated the efforts of the committee in not only in selecting the topics of the lecture series, but also on bringing the appropriate experts on the platform. He further added that sometimes communication gaps may arise between employers and employees. Leaders should be trained in nonverbal communication to eliminate this gap that could be a barrier to effective discussions.

Lecture on “ Reading Skills”

Date: 22 January, 2022

Any competitive exam or job interview can't be successfully attempted, if reading is not wide and sufficient. Shree Salimbhai Somani (Programme officer, All India Radio, Rajkot) is a passionate reader, writer, speaker with a strong concept of evolving by talking with books. Shree Somani explained that to improve students' reading comprehension, teachers should introduce the seven cognitive strategies of effective readers: activating, inferring, monitoring-clarifying, questioning, searching-selecting, summarizing, and visualizing-organizing. Further, there are six essential skills of reading comprehension including 1. Decoding 2. Fluency 3. Vocabulary 4. Sentence construction and cohesion 5. Reasoning and background 6. Working memory and attention. Dr. Mayuri Barot- Memembr, UDISHA committee of the college managed to conduct the session smoothly & also encouraged the students for question-answer session.

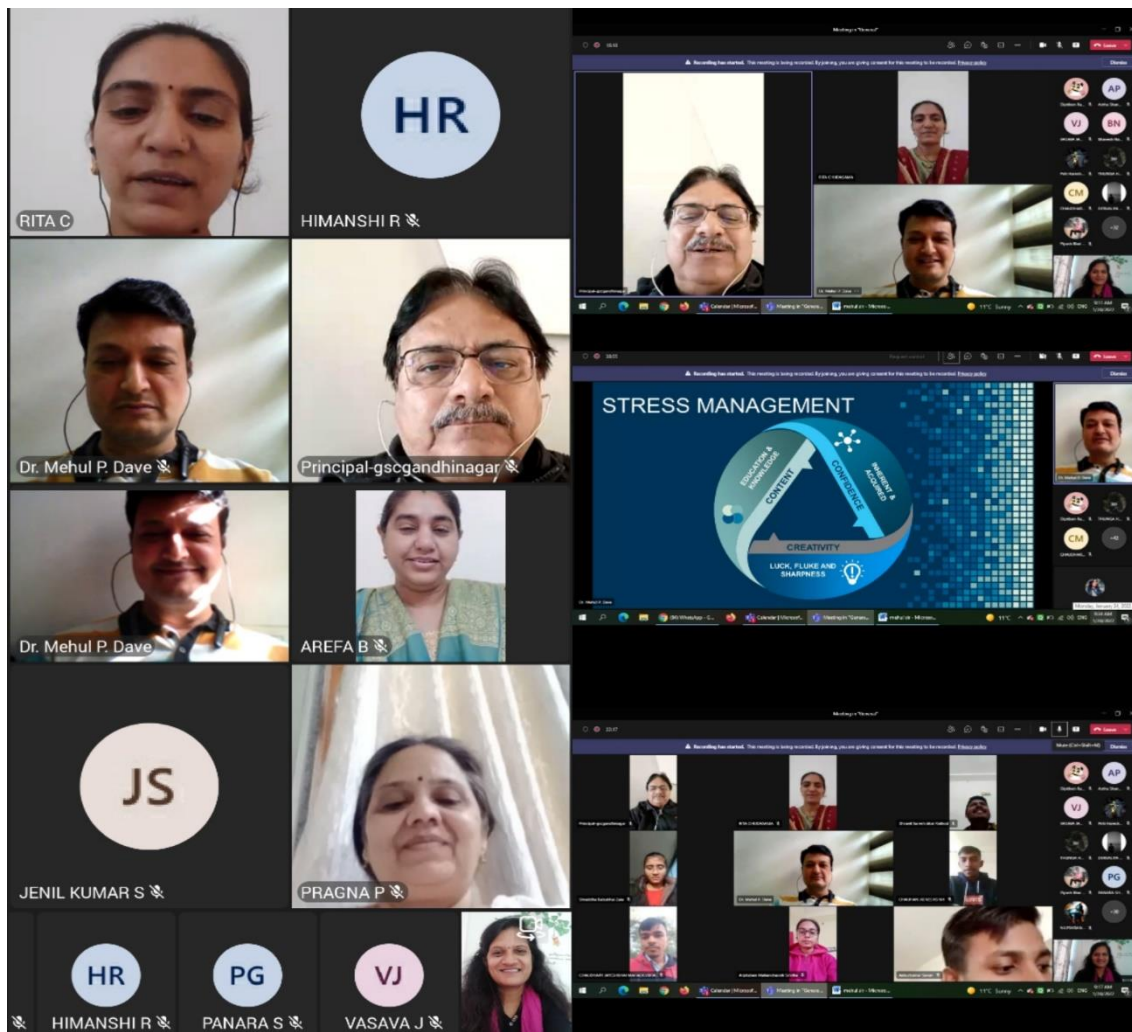

Lecture on “Manage your stress before it manages you”

Date: 24 January, 2022

Research shows college students commonly experience stress because of increased responsibilities, being homesick, academic or personal competition, personal pressure to do well, a lack of good time management and not taking enough breaks for self-care. Dr. Vasava advised the students to practice good nonverbal communication, about the dress code, to use appropriate language, not to become too much familiar or afraid, to take care while answering the questions, not to appear desperate etc. He also mentioned that your performance in an interview depends, to a significant extent, on how well you prepare for it. The session was smoothly conducted by Dr. Vivek Dave, - Memembr, UDISHA committee of the college followed by question-answer session by the students.

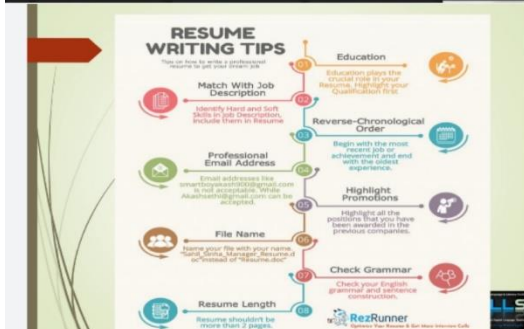
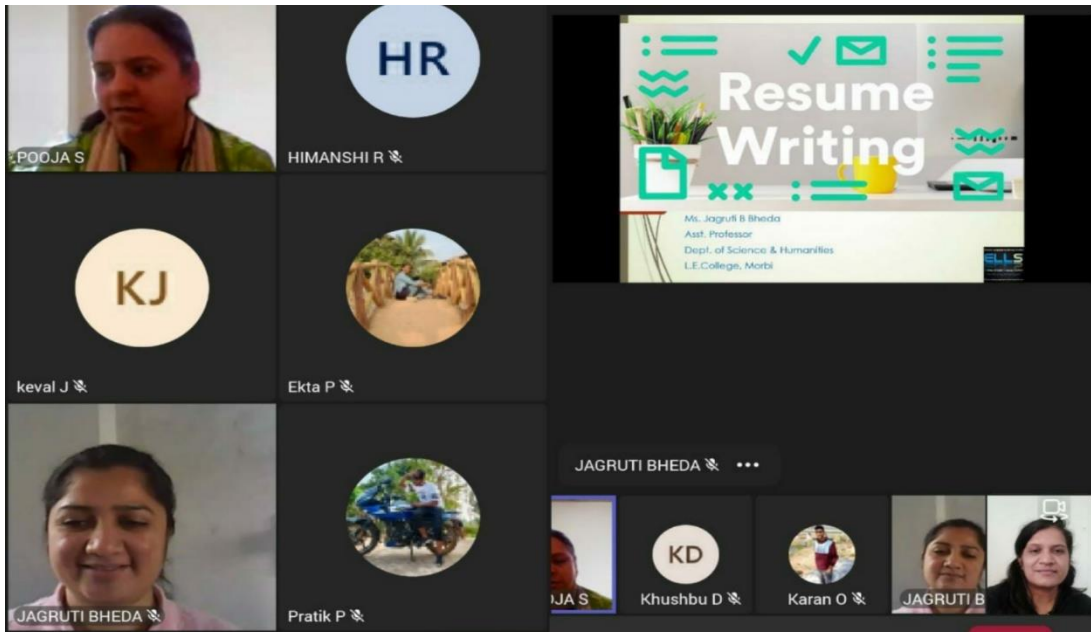

Lecture on “Write a winning resume”

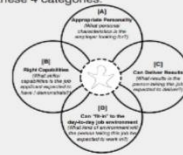
Date: 28 January, 2022

Training and placement cell plays pivotal role in counselling and guiding the students for their successful career placement which is crucial interface between the stages of completion of academic program of the student and their entry into suitable employment. Hon'ble Principal Secretary, Department of Education, Government of Gujarat and Knowledge Consortium of Gujarat, GOG has been organising mega placement fair since the academic year 2018-19 for the purpose of providing employment opportunities to all the students studying in the final year of the college. TRAINING & PLACEMENT CELL (T&P CELL) of KCG and Department of Higher education, Government of Gujarat coordinates the placement activities in every district of Gujarat state.

Data of all the students studying in the final year at Government Science College, Gandhinagar College was submitted to KCG for registration during October, 2021. A total of 399 students (B.Sc. and M.Sc.) were registered. In addition, 13 Industries were also registered for the Placement Fair by Government Science College for the placement camp. The registered entries, student consent, student choice filling and student shortlisting process by industries on very impressively designed Placement portal was regularly monitored and followed up by the members of UDISHA committee of the college under the guidance of Hon. Principal Dr. M. G. Bhatt.

The placement camp was organised on 19 March, 2022 under the lead of Government Arts College, Gandhinagar- the Nodal college of Gandhinagar district. The students of Government Science College, Gandhinagar gave interviews to about 11 companies. Out of the total 399 registered students, 334 students remained present for online interviews with various companies. Total number of interviews conducted was 583 as many students were interviewed by more than one company. Total 259 students were primary selected and were offered attractive job offers by reputed companies.

The chairman of UDISHA committee Dr. Jignasha Thumar along with the committee members Dr. Vivek Dave, Dr. Deepenkumar Gandhi, Dr. Pooja

Sharma, Dr. Rita Chudasam and Dr. Mayuri Barot from the institute co-ordinated with various companies during the online interview process, as and when asked by Nodal College, including updating the students about the interview schedules, sending the list of interested students to the companies and also remained present in almost every online selection processes followed by getting the letters of intent from assigned companies.

Figure-1: Company-wise placement of the students

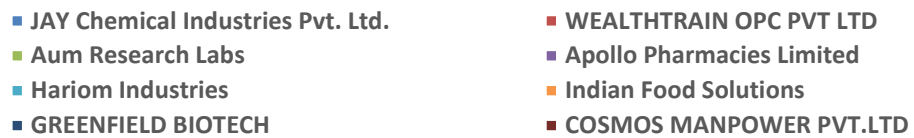
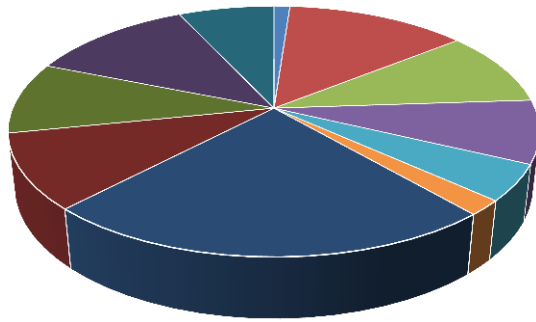
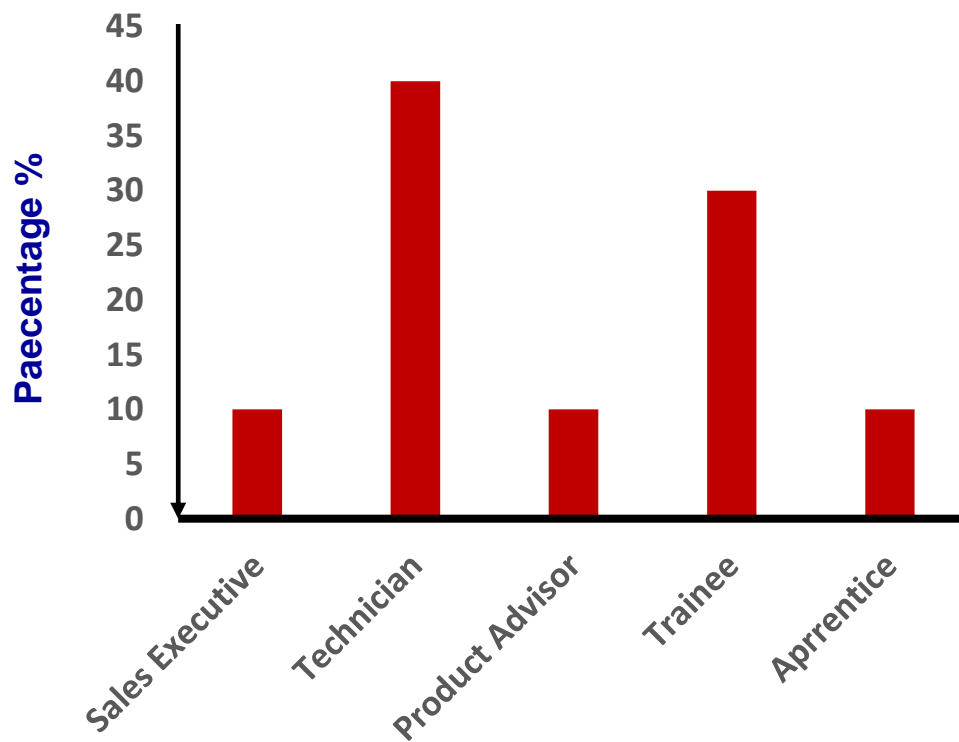
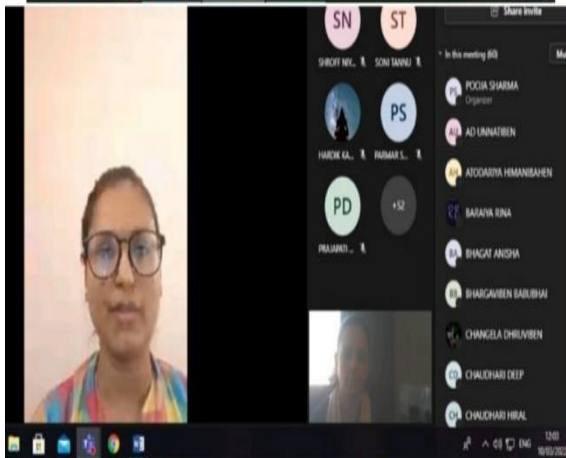
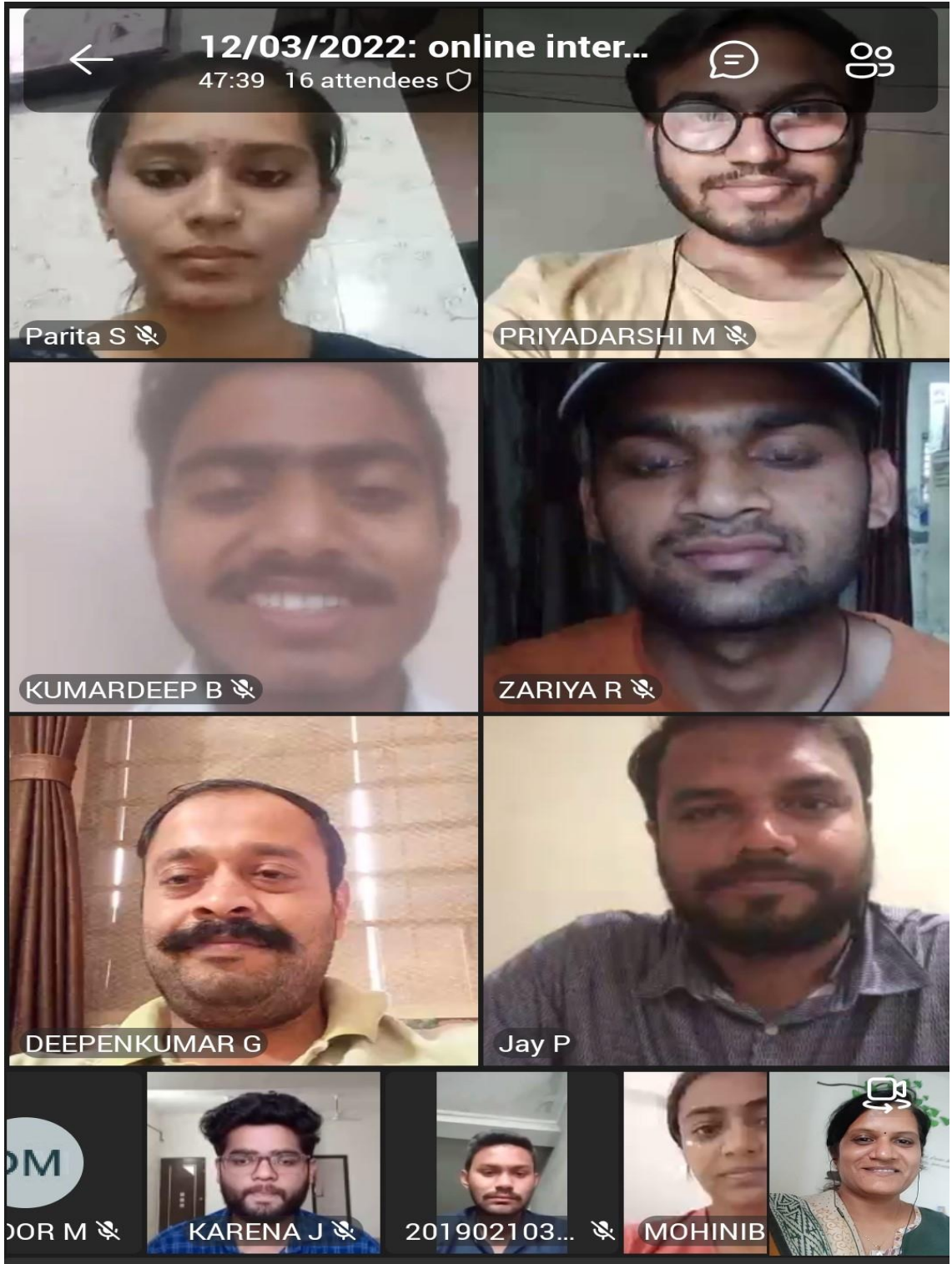


Figure-2: Percentage of the Job varieties offered to the students
