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CWDC – Collegiate Women Development Cell

Whereas the Hon'ble Supreme Court has in the judgment of Vishakha and others v. State of Rajasthan and others, reported in 1997(6) SCC 241, directed that the employers, the other responsible persons in-charge of working-places or other institutions shall prevent or deter the commission of acts any kind of harassment including sexual harassment. They shall provide the procedure for the resolution, settlement or prosecution of acts of harassment including sexual harassment by taking all required steps. Women shall have right to gender equality and to work with dignity and to have environment safe and protected from sexual harassment or abuse and appropriate work conditions in respect to health and hygiene. And whereas it is necessary and expedient to ensure the prevention of any harassment of women including sexual harassment. In pursuance of the aforesaid directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the Gujarat University constitutes a Cell for the above purpose.

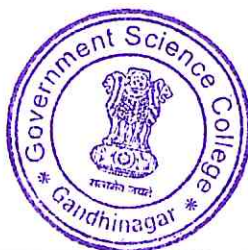

Government Science College in Gandhinagar hosted a dynamic two-day "Fruit and Vegetable Preservation" training program from September 21st to September 22nd, 2023. The event, organized in collaboration with the Office of the Deputy Director of Horticulture, SahyogSankul, Sector-11, and the College's People's Eco Club- Department of Botany and CWDC (Collegiate Women Development Cell), aimed to empower women and promote nutrition.

The training facilitated under a memorandum of understanding (MoU) between the Department of Botany at Government Science College, Sector-15, Gandhinagar, and the Office of the Director of Horticulture, Krishi Bhavan, Sector-10, witnessed the participation of 68 students.

Distinguished guests, including Hon'ble Narayan Madhu Saheb from the Office of the Commissioner of Higher Education, Sector-12, Secretariat, Gandhinagar, graced the inauguration ceremony. Their presence added gravitas to the occasion, and their guidance served as a source of inspiration for the students.


Vaishaliben P. Dr. Kovadia, Assistant Director of Horticulture at SahyogSankul, Sector-11, shed light on food and vegetable conservation strategies under the MahilaVritika Yojana operated by the Canning and Kitchen Garden Center. Sheetalben Prajapati from the Horticulture Department imparted practical knowledge on various preservation techniques, including the preparation of ginger and lemon syrup, ginger and amla sherbet, tomato ketchup, capsicum, Punjabi pickles of chili and carrot, pickles of ripe dates and lemon juice, pickles of carrots and desi chili, Karela and cashew pickles, and dates.

CBC tests are crucial in assessing overall health, diagnosing various conditions such as anemia, infections, and blood disorders. By offering these tests, the organizers aimed to promote health awareness and empower women to take charge of their well-being.

The event commenced with a brief introduction by CWDC representatives, outlining the importance of regular health check-ups and the significance of CBC tests. Trained medical professionals from the Red Cross were present to administer CBC tests with accuracy and efficiency. Female staff and students were encouraged to participate voluntarily, ensuring inclusivity and accessibility for all.

ADC Bank provided informational materials highlighting their services, including banking products, financial literacy programs, and community initiatives. This facilitated valuable engagement between participants and the bank representatives.

A total 117 number of female staff and students participated in the CBC testing, indicating a positive response to the initiative. Participants gained awareness about their health status and received personalized advice based on their test results.

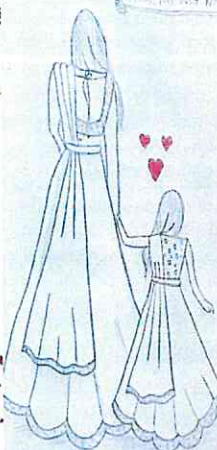

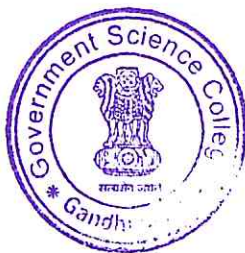

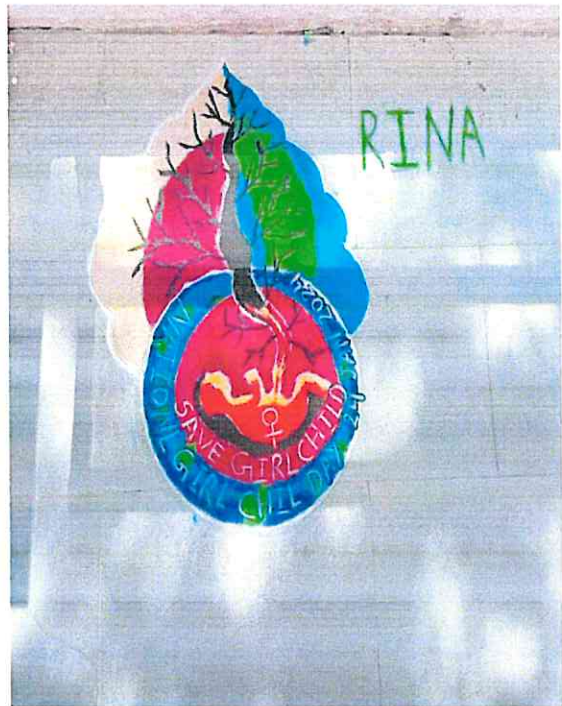

On February 10, 2024, the Gender and Resource Center, Mahila and balvikaskendra organized a one-day seminar under the SETU (Sustaining Quality Through Universities/College) project, focusing on the issues of Gender equality and the PoSH Act-2013. The event took place at the Government Science College, Gandhinagar.

Key Speakers:

- Shri MahendrabhaiMakvana
- Mrs. ShailendrakumariJhala

The seminar aimed to raise awareness about Gender equality and the significance of the PoSH Act-2013. These laws have been formulated to combat Gender equality and workplace harassment prevalent in Indian society.

- **Gender and Development:** The seminar likely delved into the relationship between gender equality and development. It may have explored topics like:
 - Challenges faced by women in social, economic, and political spheres.
 - Importance of women's empowerment for sustainable development.
 - Strategies for promoting gender equality.

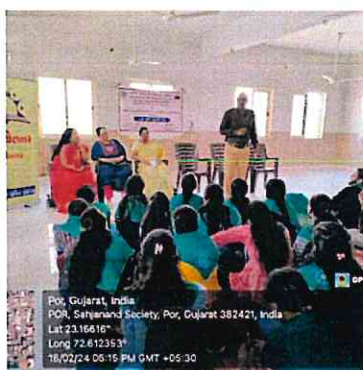


